

Club Guidelines for use of Pitch's

SLIEVERUE GAA

The club committee wishes to remind members and non-members of the following rules/regulations regarding club property and facilities:-

1. Club members are welcome to use the facilities during **Daylight Hours** for hurling, football, running and other forms of exercise, or at night-time for organised club training.
2. Non-members are welcome to attend organised events on the pitches.
3. Outside of **Daylight Hours** the pitches and facilities are out of bounds for all.
4. We expect all users of club property to respect and protect it at all times - grass pitches, astro turf pitch, nets, flags, furniture and equipment in the changing rooms, etc.
5. Ball playing in or against the walls of the dugouts is forbidden at all times.
6. Coaches/Mentors should ensure that showers and lights are switched off in the changing rooms before being vacated.
7. In the interests of health and hygiene dogs are not allowed on the property at any time.
8. All users of the property should respect the rights of adjoining property owners.
9. In all Hurling Games and Hurling Practice Sessions it shall be **mandatory** for, and the responsibility of, each individual player **to wear a helmet** with a facial guard that meets the **standard set out in IS:355** or other replacement standard as determined by the National Safety Authority of Ireland (NSAI). Such helmets shall not be modified from their original manufactured state in any circumstances”.
